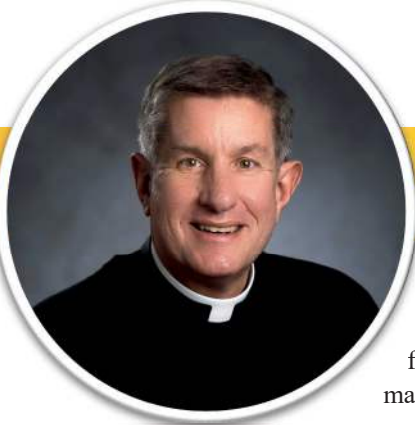

Buona Pasqua!

On this Easter Sunday we accompany Mary of Magdala to the tomb. The message of the resurrection is the gift of freedom: freedom from death that would mark the end, freedom from the bonds of remorse, of cynicism, of despair. The gift of the Resurrection invites us to make choices we've never made before: to love, to forgive, to hope and to enjoy.

Easter Sunday means different things to different people. Gathering with family and friends in celebration: easter egg hunts, easter baskets, easter clothes, easter food. But the real essence of Easter is "Being Willing to be Different." As followers of the risen Christ, we are not distinguished from others by nationality, language or custom. We do not inhabit separate cities, dress differently, nor do we eat certain foods. And yet there is something extraordinary about our lives. Being a believer in the risen Christ means that we may seem to be just like everybody else, but we are different.

Being a follower of the risen Christ means having a whole system of values that are different from the values of many people around us. This system of values helps us determine what is important in our lives and what is secondary, what we are going to stand up for and what we are going to overlook. The way we deal with our jobs, and our families, the use of time and talent are determined by the values and the relationship between the values.

The top priority for a believer is the life of Christ. As baptized persons, we have been given a share of the life of Jesus. We are called and empowered to receive the life and love of Jesus in our hearts and extend that life and love to those around us. That's what the life of a believer is all about, and that's why it is more important than anything else. The way we think about success and failure, the way we look at other people, especially those in need, the significance we find in civic and political life, the way we view sickness and death; all these matters are colored by the life of Jesus that is in us.

The difference does not lead us to try to get out of the world. In fact, the life of Christ in believers impels us to live the world as he did. It is a good world, deep down, because it's God's world. That is why Jesus came to save it, to give it a new value and a new worth through participation in his life. Our task as believers is to bring the world that life. We may not be a high-level decision maker or influential guides of public opinion. We may not be important at all, as the world counts importance. But we do have a part to play in the world's salvation, and we play that part by being as consistently, as completely, as practically aligned with the Lord's priorities.

We may want to be just like everybody else in many ways, but in the ways that make the most difference to ourselves and to the world around us, we are different. Being a believer in the risen Lord means understanding and welcoming the difference.

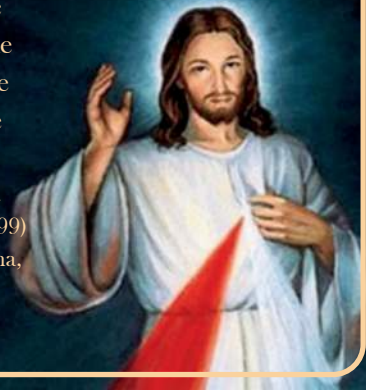

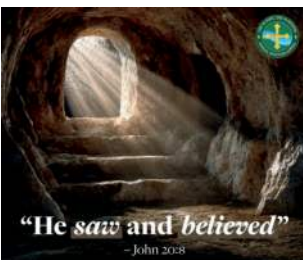

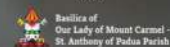
