Follow me

On the road to Emmaus, the disciples come to recognize Jesus' presence among them. Spend today looking at each person you encounter as though he or she is Jesus. See Jesus in the child tantrum, or the coworker who brought you coffee as well as the one who said an unkind word.

Jesus' invitation is not a distant, historical echo, but a present, urgent reality. It is a call that transcends time, circumstances and personal brokenness, seeking to transform lives through grace. Throughout the New Testament and in today's faith experiences, the voice of Jesus calls us to a purposeful, holy life. Jesus calls us in four distinct ways.

From darkness into His Marvelous Light. This means leaving behind a life focused on selfish ambition, social status or despair and entering a life of purpose and truth. He calls us when we are not perfect, but precisely in our messy, broken seasons, offering a new identity.

To be with Him. The foundational call is not to work, but to relationship. Jesus calls us to come and follow him so that we might be with him, sharing a life changing love.

To a Higher calling. An upward calling that lifts us above the mundane to pursue holiness in wholeness.

To Action. He invites us to be active participants in bringing forth his Kingdom.

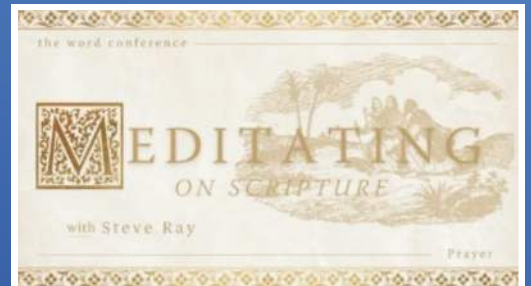

APRIL is Child Abuse Prevention Month

The Catholic Church is committed to protecting children and helping survivors heal.



Steps to Prevent ABUSE

Communicate with Your Children

Open communication with your children helps you identify grooming behaviors and warning signs before they escalate into abuse.

Educate Yourself and Your Children on Abuse

Parents and guardians should empower their children to protect themselves from harm and to report abuse. Visit the diocesan Safe Environment webpage (doy.org/safe-environment/) to access reporting resources and free VIRTUS online training. This training will help you recognize the signs of abuse and learn how to prevent or report it.

Identify and Report Warning Signs of Child Abusers

Grooming involves abusers appearing kind and generous to build trust while secretly intent on luring a minor into an inappropriate relationship. These offenders often isolate victims through gifts, secret-keeping, or rule-breaking, sometimes manipulating families and communities for years to hide their true motives.

Holding Offenders ACCOUNTABLE

To help hold offenders accountable, report all suspected abuse to local public authorities. You can also contact Mr. Dominic Colucy, Victim Assistance Coordinator to make a report and seek outreach for the abused.

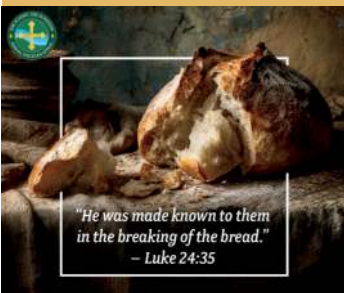
