A Debt of Love: Honoring Our Mothers



Mothers, we know that you have a twenty-four hour a day job, one which demands not only all your time, but also all your attention and energy. Because of that realization, we honor you today, in the fashion that we should give to you every day, for all you do for us and for the family.

Few of us show our mothers the debt of love, honor and respect that we should. We know we don't, and we feel guilty about it. So, on Mother's Day, we try to make up for our failures by giving Mom gifts to symbolize our true feeling of affection and appreciation.

We give all sorts of gifts which range from the extravagant to the simple, from store-bought to the homemade, from fancy flowers to fattening food. Today, I want to suggest gifts of the non-materialistic, non-commercial nature, that are necessary in the family and should be given each day.

Let me begin by speaking to you, the daughters and sons. Children, no matter what age you are, from nine months to ninety years, no matter how many children of your own you have, the gift you must give your mother every day is honor. She is the instrument

through which God gave you life. She put her life in jeopardy in order to give you birth. She has sacrificed many of the luxuries of life in order to feed, clothe and educate you. We must never be dishonorable to our mothers in the way that we speak to her or about her. We must also honor her in the way we live.

One day, several convicts were in the prison library flipping through a catalog. On one of the pages was a picture of a lovely home. One of the prisoners said, "I wish I could give my mother a house like that to live in". Another pointed to a nice car and wished he could give his mother that car. Then they noticed their friend Bill was just staring at the magazine, so they asked him what he would like to give his mother. He said, "I wish I could give my mother a more honorable son". That man was grieving about the fact that his life and actions dishonored his mother. Whether we want it to be this way or not, the way we live is a reflection upon our parents. So, if we really want to honor her, we should live in a way that she will be proud of.

I realize that there are times when we think our mothers know absolutely nothing about the way life is today. Mothers are much wiser than we are. She has the wisdom that can only be gained through years of living. Remember that our mothers are smarter than we think.

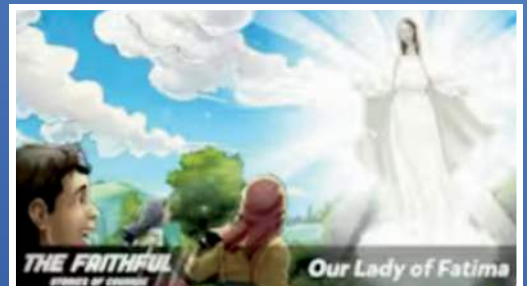

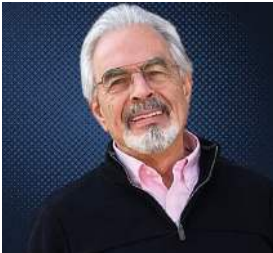
