The Faithful Witness



There is a story that when Jesus returned to heaven after his death and resurrection the Archangel Gabriel was surprised to see him back so soon. Thirty-three years is not a long time, especially when you think about the importance of the task he had been given to do.

‘Back so soon?’ Gabriel said to Jesus. ‘Well, I would have stayed longer but they crucified me,’ Jesus replied. ‘So they crucified you, so you failed,’ said Gabriel. ‘Not necessarily,’ said Jesus, ‘you see I called together a little group of disciples; they will carry on my work.’ ‘And what if they fail?’ asked Gabriel. ‘I have no other plans,’ Jesus answered.

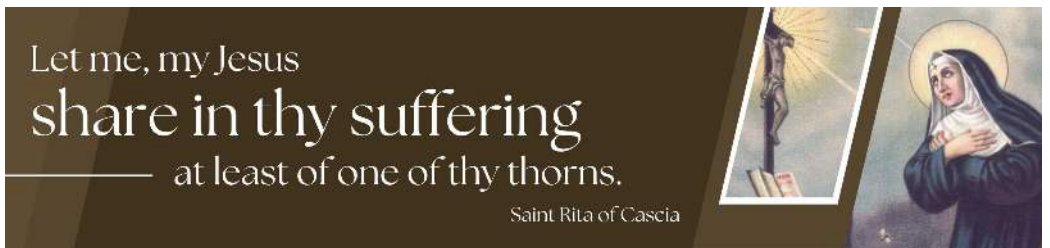

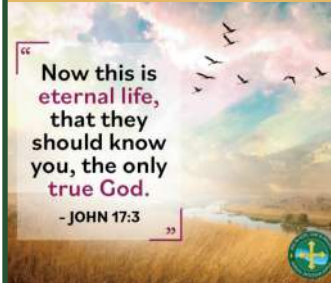

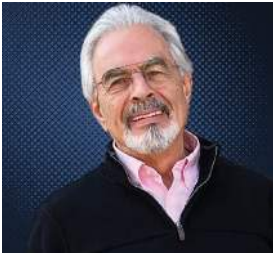
