Forgiveness is central to our Christian identity, as this Sunday's Gospel illustrates. The disciples were supposed to be Jesus' closest friends. It means we, like Christ, don't hold their failings against them. We extend to all the same love that Christ offers us. 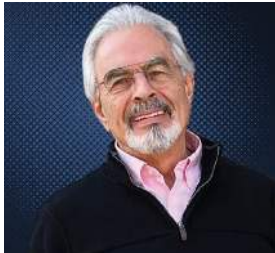
